- Academic Integrity: Submitting AI generated work that you represent as your own will be considered as academic dishonesty. If AI generated work is utilized, students should use the proper citation of the source. Use of AI generated content without citing will be considered plagiarism. Students should review the <u>Academic Honesty policy</u>.
- Responsible Use: The use of AI tools must be in compliance with The School District of Shiocton <u>Student Education Technology Acceptable</u> <u>Use Policy</u>.
- Respect of Privacy: All systems should never be used to disclose or access private information of yourself or others.
- Always Evaluate what AI Generates! Students should review the materials for accuracy and appropriateness. It is also advised to fact check information provided by AI. When using AI to collect information, always consider the potential biases and/or limitations of the content.
