

LUNCH/BREAKFAST Grades EC-8 (2016/2017)

Breakfast Daily cost for grades EC-8 \$1.10 Reduced Prices: \$.30

The School District of Shiocton offers variety of breakfast items to choose from. The breakfast program has two reimbursable breakfast Four food items are offered daily. When purchasing a reimbursable breakfast 3 out of the 4 item must be taken. A full serving (1cup) of fruit is offered daily, 1/2c fruit must be on the students tray prior to purchasing. A la carte forms will be in registration packets and on our website. Please fill out return to Deb Danke Nutrition Program Director. For families convenience the menu will be posted on our website, the link and in the cafeteria.

Lunch Daily costs for grades EC-8 grade \$2.40 Reduced prices: \$.40

Shiocton School District has an “Offer vs Serve” system. Five components will be offered each day. These five components are protein, vegetable, fruit, Whole grain breads and milk. Your student will need to take three of the five items offered. Due to the Healthy Hungry-free kids act of 2010, when purchasing a reimbursable lunch a full serving (1/2cup) of fruit and (3/4c) of vegetables will be offered, 1/2c serving must be on the students tray prior to purchasing a meal. The School District of Shiocton encourages your child(ren) to take all five of the food components for a healthier, more nutritious lunch. **EC-8 students are not offered a la carte items as an option for lunch.**

Milk Fees.

There is a milk fee for elementary students within the Shiocton School District. The fees will be \$18.00 a year for Grades K5, 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5. Grades Early Childhood & K4 will be charged \$9.00 a year. The fees must be paid separately from all other fees including the lunch account. Please do not include this amount with lunch, activity fees, etc. The milk fee can be paid during the August registration dates or on line through e funds for schools.

Milk

One milk is included with each meal, if an extra milk is purchased the cost is \$.30. Just a reminder, if your child(ren) receives free meals and they choose to bring a cold lunch, money needs to be in the account prior to purchasing a milk or the students can pay in cash. **This is separate from the milk fees.**

Free/Reduced Program

Free/Reduced applications will be mailed to each family after July 1. Please fill out the application form, return at registration or to the school offices before the start of the school year. If you are unsure if your family qualifies, fill out the application and return them to Debba Danke Nutrition Program Director. If at any time during the school year your financial situation changes ie: loss of employment, an application can be submitted at that time. All information on the application must be accurate or the form will be returned to you, which will delay your qualification for the free and /or reduced program. **Reduced pricing is set by DPI, confirmed in July. This program is confidential**

Key pad numbers

Students are assigned a four digit number. These numbers are connected to the students foodservice accounts. Students should know their numbers and keep them confidential. K4-K5 will have lunch cards with their key pad numbers on them. The lunch cards are handed out and collected daily by your student (s) teacher. The four digit numbers is your student (s) until they graduate. The number does not change.

When your account reaches \$10.00 or below

The School District of Shiocton Skylert automated calling system will call, email, and/or text the primary person on the family account to inform you of your balance. You will receive a call on Mondays and Thursdays when balances are \$10.00 or below. Just like a checking account, the account must remain above zero (in the positive). You will receive a call on Tuesdays and Fridays when the balances are in the negative. If your balance falls below \$-20.00, you will be mailed a reminder and/or a letter stating that your child/children are unable to purchase a meal or ala carte until the balance is paid and has a positive balance. Families are able to make payments by check, cash, or e funds for schools. Money for your family account can be dropped off at the Elementary Office, or to Debbra Danke Nutrition Program Director, or on-line through Skyward Family Access E funding for schools program. Information on how to pay online will be provided during registration or go to our website www.shiocton.k12.wi.us for instructions Please keep your phone numbers, address and emails current. The breakfast/lunch program at Shiocton Schools is a family account program. Your student(s) are able to purchase a meal or breakfast a la carte item from one account with a separate key pad number for each student. Money is deposited into your family account **prior** to purchases being made. Only one check is needed for all family members.

Please pay lunch account separate from other school fees.
