



High School Mathematics Teacher

The School District of Shiocton is seeking an educator to join our high school team as a Gr 9 - 12 math teacher beginning Semester 2 of the 2017-2018 school year. Specifically, the teacher will provide instruction for courses such as Algebra I, II, Geometry, and Introduction to Algebra.

The preferred candidate will have a minimum of one year of teaching math in Grades 7 – 12 *or* demonstrated successful student teacher placement within that grade range. Additionally, the candidate will have a demonstrated competency in strong classroom management and integration of technology, as well as solid interpersonal skills and a history of collaboration. Experience with/knowledge of Discovery Ed's Math Techbook, On Core, or Big Ideas is a plus.

Applicants must possess or be eligible for a Wisconsin DPI License for Mathematics (#1400). Salary is commensurate with background, education, and experience.
