



## **Occupational Therapist Job Posting**

The Shiocton School District is seeking a part-time Occupational Therapist to begin on or around November 15, 2017.

Primary responsibilities include working with children in grade levels Early Childhood-12th grade. This includes instructing and supporting students in both special education and regular education environments, informing regular education teachers of IEP components if applicable, and progress monitoring of student performance. The therapist will be responsible for determining eligibility for occupational therapy as a related service and completing of related reports. The therapist will participate in IEP team meetings and monthly special education building meetings.

Candidates should display strong organizational skills and an ability to maintain student records and confidentiality, as well as an ability to interact in a positive and constructive manner with students, families, and staff members.

Applicants must possess or be eligible for a Wisconsin DPI License for School Occupational Therapist (O051). Salary is commensurate with background, education, and experience.
