### Digital Learning

We have now been doing digital learning for a few weeks. Overall, it has been a success. While it is not the ideal way to deliver instruction, both teachers and students are making the most of it. We have seen a consistent 94-95%% attendance rate for High School students, and between a 90% and 94% attendance rate for Middle School students. My goal going into this was to have at least a 90% participation rate and we have exceeded that every day so far.
