



Shiocton School District 2020 - 2021 District Goals

GRADES PK-6

By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, 75% of the full academic year students in Grades K-6 will meet their individual targeted growth score as measured by one of the following: STAR, Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark, or PALS.

GRADES 7-12

Realize a graduation rate of 100% for full academic year members of the Class of 2021.

Through the use of our ACT preparatory methods, we will meet the following benchmarks for the percentage of our Junior class that is college ready:

- English - 44% or more college ready
- Math - 33% or more college ready
- Reading - 33% or more college ready
- Science - 32% or more college ready

DISTRICT & COMMUNITY

The District will maintain a healthy and safe learning environment by implementing best practices to address concerns caused by the pandemic. These practices will be based upon guidance and recommendations by the CDC, DHS, and other health organizations. The District Administrator and the school nurse will review these practices twice a month; updates to practices will be made as needed.

The District will review the Reopening Plan monthly.
