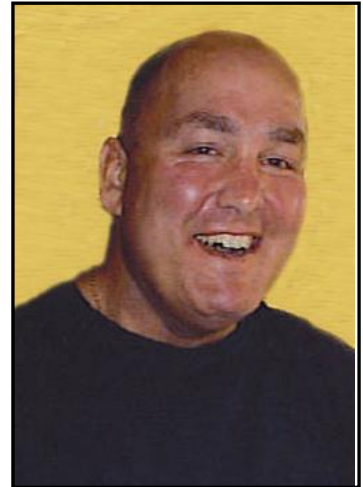




Patrick D. Van Alstine Memorial Scholarship

Patrick Van Alstine's family established this scholarship in celebration of his accomplishments and to continue his mission of believing in the power of a good education. According to his loving family, Pat was a truly special person. He was a fantastic son, an outstanding brother, a caring husband and an amazing father. Pat was a truly well-rounded individual; a serious, thoughtful and reflective person yet one who was also able to fill a room with laughter. He was a sports enthusiast as well as an American history buff. Pat demonstrated excellence in his professional life as a high school principal and educator where his motivation and caring touched thousands of young people and allowed many to reach their fullest potential. He was passionate about education and believed in students' potential to contribute to society in many ways. Pat's retirement as principal of Shiocton High School came in 2006 due to health issues. Pat's life was cut short in February 2008, at the age of 40, after a five-year struggle with Lou Gehrig's disease.



Eligibility:

Graduating seniors from Shiocton High School who have demonstrated the following:

- Academic achievement
- Leadership
- Optimistic orientation to life.

Award Amount:

Up to \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship award for tuition expenses.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the Shiocton High School Scholarship Selection Committee. Notification of the winner will be forwarded to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released upon submission of the following to the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region: completed scholarship verification form located at www.cffoxvalley.org/scholarships and verification of full time student status (class schedule with credits listed). After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school in the first semester of the freshman year of college. This scholarship cannot be deferred. Most communications between the Community Foundation and the student will be via email. **Please keep us advised of your current email address.**

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as full time student for the first semester of freshman year of college.
