- Create a classroom environment resulting in high levels of learning and the personal growth of each student
- Develop positive home/school relationships with diverse family structures
- Utilize assessment data to document student progress and academic/functional skill achievement.
- Provide timely written progress reports to parents/guardians and administration within the guidelines of the district practices including the writing of CCR- IEPs meeting legal requirements and standards
- Work collaboratively with specialists, therapists, and teacher assistants by sharing knowledge, skills, and resources as a member of a supportive team
- Be able to successfully work in self-contained and inclusive teaching environments
- Knowledge and experience in the utilization of behavior management systems including conducting Functional Behavioral Assessments and designing Behavioral Intervention Plans
- Demonstrate the willingness for professional growth
- Trained or willing to be trained in NonViolent Crisis Intervention
