



Middle School Teacher/Athletic Director

Within the academic area, the successful candidate will demonstrate a solid ability to collaborate with colleagues and implement sound instructional practices, including the integration of technology. S/he will also demonstrate a proven ability to establish relationships with staff, students and parents. Experience teaching Big Ideas or Math Expressions is desired but not required. Experience teaching Lucy Calkins' Readers/Writers Workshop or Collections ELA is also desired but not required, as is previous experience teaching in the middle level.

Within the athletic area, the successful candidate should be energetic with a strong desire to work collaboratively with coaches, classroom teachers, and administration to meet the needs of our athletes and athletic programs. Demonstrated knowledge of WIAA rules and high school athletic programs is required. Demonstrated leadership, supervisory, and budgetary experience is preferred, as is experience with rSchool. Preference may be given to applicants with prior AD and/or coaching experience.

Applicants must possess, or be eligible for, a valid Wisconsin DPI License in one of the following areas: Elementary (1088, 1083) / Regular Education (1777)/English (1300)/Mathematics (1400), or other as applicable, as well as a School Administrator license (#51).
